



Guidelines: BCIA Mentor of the Year Nominations

Purpose:

To select a BCIA Registrant who holistically espouses the values of being a BCIA mentor

Eligibility:

- Demonstrates commitment to the Mentoring Program over many years (suggest 5 year minimum)
- Actively engages with their mentee
- Recognizes that the mentoring relationship has benefited the mentee and has not simply been an administrative task
- Promotes the mentoring program and has contributed to its betterment
- Number of mentoring situations, but not at the expense of quality (i.e. not simply a numbers game)
- Part of a broader commitment to the BCIA

DOCUMENTATION FOR MENTOR OF THE YEAR

1. Nominating Agrologist, branch
2. Name of the nominee
3. Date and place of birth (if known)
4. Reason for the nomination
5. Contribution to the Mentoring Program
6. Service to the profession at the branch, provincial and national level
7. Honours and awards (list honors and awards already held, if known)
8. 1 or 2 letters of reference to strengthen the nomination – optional
